Ages 2-3

Ages 6-7

Tidy their room · sweep · help cook · pack their bag · sort recycling

Ages 8-9

Load the dishwasher · fold laundry · rake · walk the pet · make a snack

Ages 10-12

Vacuum · take out trash · do a laundry load · help with dinner · wash the car
